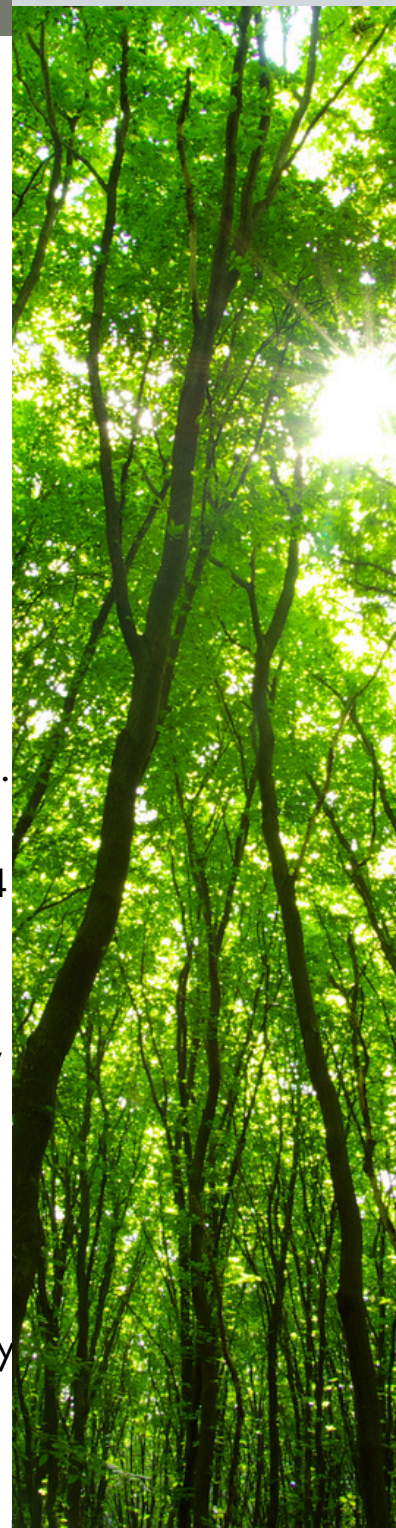
Saturday Family Movie Matinee: Held the third Saturday of every month at 1 pm. On June 20 we will be screening DC League of Super-Pets (2022)

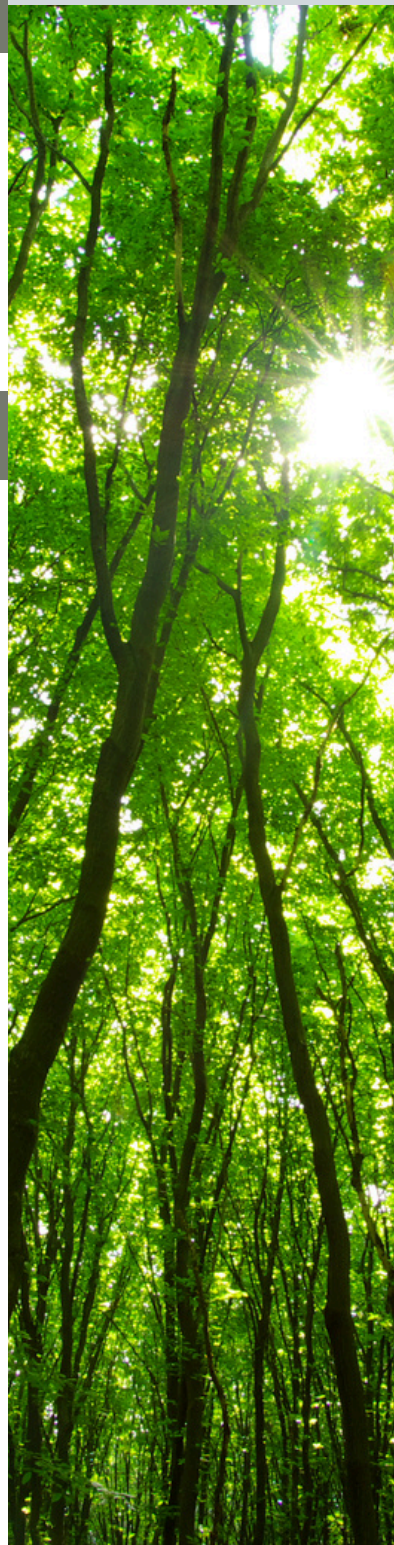
