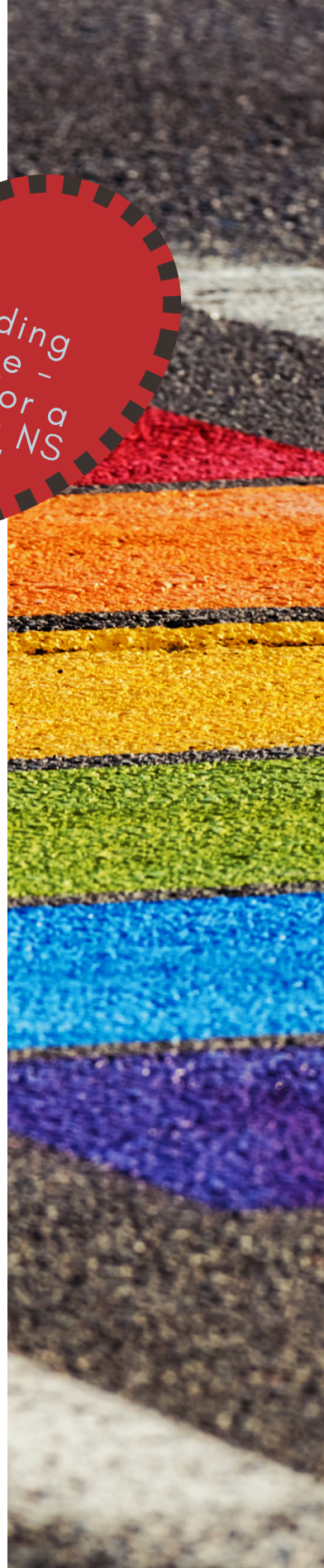

Join us every second Saturday of the month, when we speak and practice German. Please note that this is a conversation group rather than lessons. Bis bald!

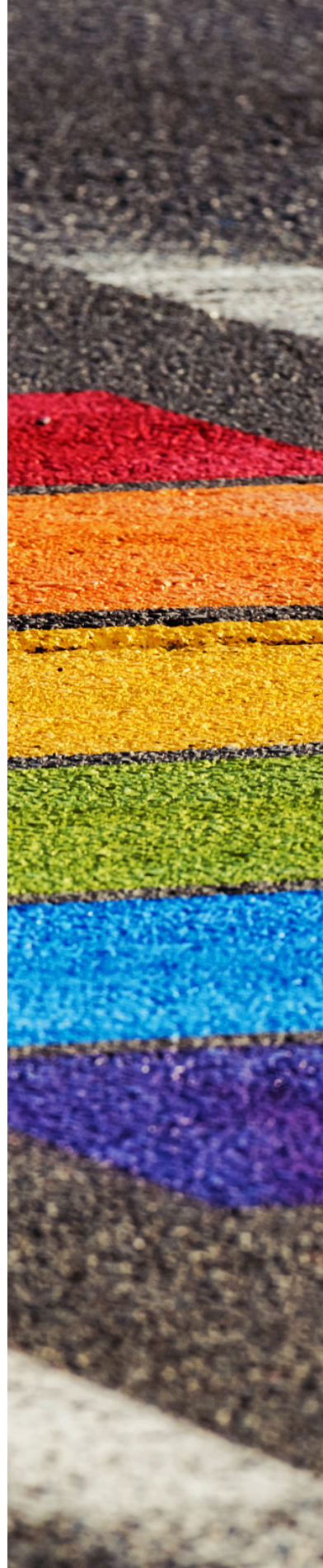
## COMMUNITY PANTRY

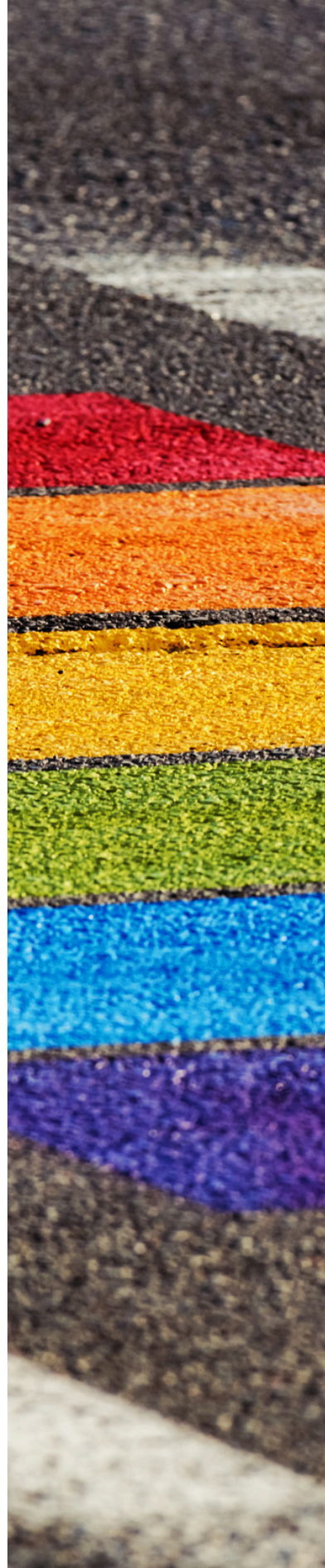

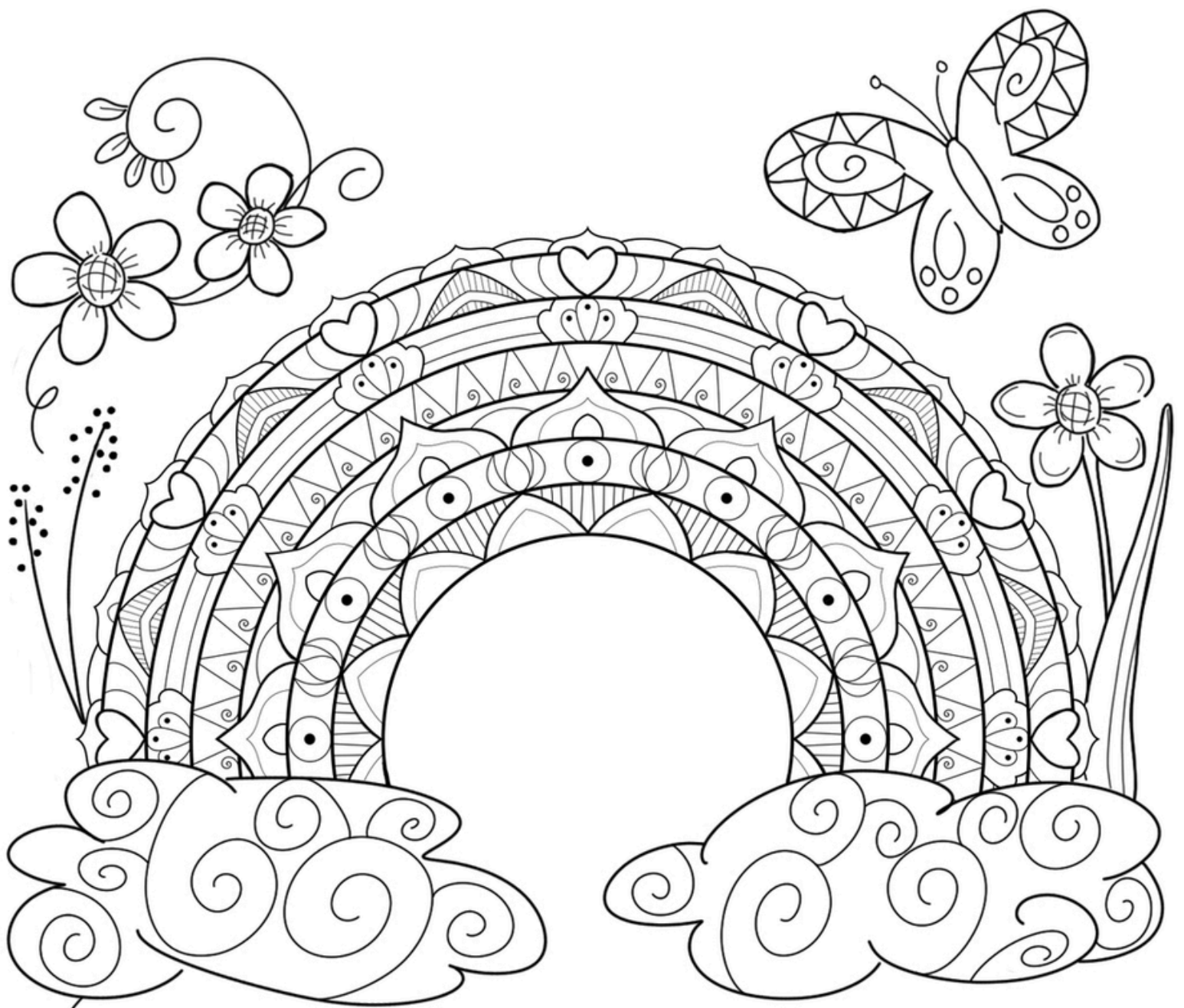
